





What is an ISR?

Information Service Representatives (ISR) are Al-Anon members with at least one year in the program.

ISRs are an important link in providing information and service information to Al-Anon members throughout Orange County!

Each meeting elects an ISR and it is suggested an Alternate ISR (A-ISR) to represent them at Intergroup meetings.

What is an ISR?

At meetings, ISRs have a voice and vote on Intergroup activates and carry the message between the meeting you represent and the OC Intergroup.

Al-Anon members who are also members of another program such as Alcoholics Anonymous MAY NOT serve as an ISR or as a member of the Service Board.

This help us to keep the focus on Al-Anon.

ISRs will need to register with Southern California World Service whenever there is a rotation of leadership within a group.

INTERGROUP PROCEDURES

Our Al-Anon Information Service / Intergroup is a local service established and maintained by several Districts (57, 60, 63, and 66) in the Orange County and Greater Long Beach Area. See the current Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual for the specific functions performed by Intergroup.

If you are registering as a NEW Information Service Representative (ISR), or Alternate ISR, you MUST register no less than 7 days prior to the upcoming Intergroup Meeting in order to have a voice and vote.

Meeting Schedule

All Orange County Intergroup and Service Board meetings are held <u>via Zoom</u> (unless otherwise notified):

Intergroup meetings begin at 7:30 pm and usually end before 9:00 pm. First-time Information Service Representatives (ISR) are encouraged to attend an orientation session that begins 30 minutes prior to each meeting (7:00 pm). The new ISR orientation presentation is available for download here.

A Spanish Interpreter can be provided at all Intergroup meetings.

Intergroup meetings for 2024 are:

Service Board meetings for 2024 are:

January 17, March 20, May 15, July 17, September 18 and November 20

Register/Group Change Forms

Whenever there is a rotation of leadership within a group, for making group changes, or for registering a new group, the group (usually through the Group Representative, Current Mailing Address, ISR, or Group Secretary) must inform Southern California World Service (SCWS). Do that by clicking on the button below to complete the Al-Anon Group Change/New Group Registration form, which includes Group Service Position and Phone Contact changes. This will inform the Area Group Records Coordinator (AGRC) for SCWS to update the World Service Office (WSO) Al-Anon meeting database, as appropriate.

PLEASE NOTE: The Information Service Representative (ISR)/Alternate ISR information is NOT maintained by the WSO or SCWS. The Orange County and Greater Long Beach Al-Anon Information Service (OC and Greater LB AIS) will be informed of these service position changes and will update and maintain this information for Intergroup. The Group Secretary information is also only maintained by the AIS office.

AL-ANON GROUP RECORDS

WHERE DOES YOUR GROUP INFORMATION GO?

These forms are only used for Al-Anon meetings.

To register or submit updates for an **Alateen** meeting, you must complete the Alateen Registration/Group Records Change Form (GR-3) found <u>here</u>.

If you are registering as a new Group Representative, you must register:

- by the first Saturday of May in order to vote at the May Assembly.
- by the first Saturday of November in order to vote at the November Assembly.

The Area Assemblies are held on the third Saturdays of May and November.





Example: ISR-Mark, Artesia, Mon 7:00pm, D57

Alternate ISR if voting in place of the ISR:

ALT-V-Name, Meeting Location, Day & Time, District

Example: ALT-V-Mark, Artesia, Mon 7:00pm, D57

Guest and non-voting Alt-ISRs
